Rotary Club to donate \$10,000 for community garden

WHAT: The Metropolitan Savannah Rotary Club will present the Greenbriar Children's Center with a check totaling nearly \$10,000 and work with Greenbriar students and staff to harvest and plant the Center's community garden that the Club built in September.

WHY: The Metropolitan Savannah Rotary Club chose Greenbriar as its 2013-14 service partner, working with the Center to build a vibrant community garden at its campus on Savannah's westside.
